

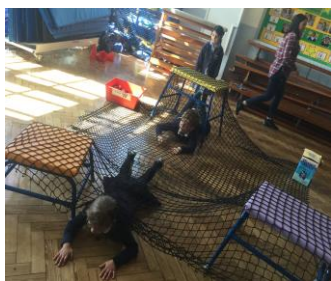
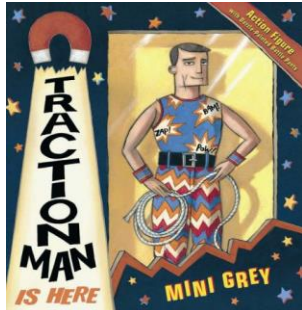


Key Stage 1 Summer term overview

Our learning

We are basing all our learning on the core book *Traction Man* by Mini Grey this half term.

We had our Big Bang on the first day back to launch the book where we had to break codes and other mysteries, as well as complete a super obstacle course! These activities gave us clues to the book.

Assessment

Year 1 will be taking a Phonics Screen in June where they will read real and nonsense words using their phonics knowledge. Year 2 will be taking a maths and reading SATs test at the end of May. This is nothing to worry about. The children are being prepared for these in class and supported by the reading and homework they are completing at home.

How you can help:

- Make sure your child brings in their **book bag** every day with a water bottle and their reading book.
- PE is one of Traction Man's favourite subjects to keep him strong and healthy! We will have PE on 3 days so PE kits need to be in school on Mondays, taking them home on Friday to be washed.
- Write your child's name and class on all clothing, especially jumpers and PE kits.
- For safety reasons, the children need to have their hair tied up and no earrings on PE days.
- Enjoy completing the whole school homework projects - details of these will be in the Chisenhale Chatter
- Please listen to your child read their coloured reading book every day, as well as reading other books to them to listen and enjoy. This makes a huge difference!
- Practise mental maths skills including on Sumsdog
- Visit free museums and libraries - our school library is open after school on Tuesdays.
