

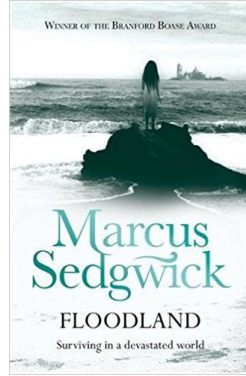


Welcome back UKS2!

How can you help?

Frag
